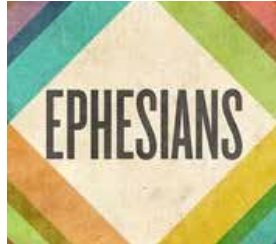
Book of Ephesians
